Visit History Page Table Redesign

What is it?

The list of visits on the Visit History page is being redesigned to use a new table layout for managing visits.

Why is it useful?

This new table layout improves consistency and makes it easier for providers and practice managers to manage previous visits on the visit history page.

When should I use it?


Use the visit history page to:

- Find information about past visits
- Chart visits (if charting is enabled)
- View chat history
- Write prescriptions (if ePrescribe is enabled)
- Download the visit summary
- Bill for a visit (if billing is enabled)






Users with these roles see visits for all providers in the practice.



A new column for "Provider" is available. As before the age can be filtered by provider.







1. In the main navigation menu, click the Visit History tab




2. Use the filters to narrow in on a subset of visits











3. Or use search to find a visit by keyword



4. The new table layout shows key visit information:




Use the actions (left to right) to download a summary, access chat messages, view the chart/identify unsigned charts (if you have a charting enabled), get more information (opens the sidebar).

 - Blue for signed charts
 - Orange for unsigned charts
 - Pink for unsigned co-signatures
