Patient Visit History Differentiation

What is it?

The visit history page allows patients to access important information about completed visits. In its current state, past visits are indiscernible from one another, making it difficult for patients to access the specific records they are seeking. In our new update, we will be adding appointment details to each visit and grouping visits by year so that patients can more easily identify the past visit they are looking for.

Why is it useful?


Visit summaries are accessed through the visit history page and contain helpful information like doctor's notes, prescription details, provider information, etc. In order for a patient to access this summary for a specific visit today, they have to click on each visit one by one to discover its details. This new improvement will eliminate this issue. Additionally, by providing all necessary information up front should reduce the amount of times patients reach out to ask questions which then free up clinical users.

When should I use it?

The visit history page is available to all patients by default. Any patient hoping to obtain information about a past visit can access this page.



Mobile




Desktop

Additional Information

Today there is a default Date Range filter that is set to the Last 30 Days. With the average days from a patient's first visit to their second being roughly 121 we know that patients are most likely arriving to this page and wondering where their past visit is. To solve for that confusion we will be ensuring ALL past visits display on this page.

In the event a patient has had many completed visits we will only display the 20 most recent as we do on other pages today to avoid long load times. As the patient scrolls down another 20 completed visits will display, so on and so forth. However, 12% of all patients have more than 3 completed visits.
