# "Create a Patient" Demographics

### What is it?

All day calendar blocks allow a clinical user to be set as available and/or schedulable for an entire day with one click. When clinical users are creating patients and the practice has ePrescribe enabled, the following fields will be included as optional:

- Gender
- Address

In addition, a phone number validation has been added to ensure the phone number entered is active.

If a patient's DOB is under 18 years old, fields for adding height and weight will populate for the provider.

### Why is it useful?

Allows for additional information to be collected and entered by providers in the Create a Patient screen which may be needed to process a prescription. This saves time and improves the experience on the clinical user's side. Previously, they did not have these demographic fields available to them when creating a patient, so it required the use of administrative work to edit the patient profile and add this data later.

### When should I use it?

The new demographic fields and validations can be used by a provider who is adding a patient using "Create a Patient" to a practice which uses ePrescribe.

## How does it work?

Go to either the Scheduling page or Patients page and click **Create Patient**.

1. If you have ePrescribe enabled, you will now see extra fields required for prescriptions.
